President and General Director The Daniels began their 45-year ministry in the West Indies on the island of Dominica where they served six years and established four churches.

In 1980, God moved upon the Daniels heart to begin a ministry for the English-speaking population in the town of Carolina, Puerto Rico. In 1981, the Daniels through God's direction began Calvary Baptist Tabernacle in Carolina, Puerto Rico.

In 1983, as the church grew, a Christian day school began for the purpose of training children to live for the Lord. Today, the school has an enrollment of almost 350 students in grades K-12. In 1995, the Lord burdened Dr. Daniels heart to begin Calvary Baptist Bible College for training students from the neighboring islands of the West Indies. To date the college has graduated over 130 students from over 22 different countries throughout the West Indies, South America, and Africa.


In 1999, due to the number of Spanish speaking people who were won to the Lord, Calvary Baptist Tabernacle started a successful Spanish ministry which continues today.

In 2000, a ministry to the deaf community was started and all English services are translated for the deaf. The Bible college teaches sign language to its students and today there have graduates of the Bible college who have deaf ministries in their home countries.

In January 2019, Dr. Daniels stepped aside as the missionary pastor of Calvary Baptist Tabernacle to follow God's leading in expanding the Bible college ministry to St. Vincent and also to help establish churches throughout the West Indies.

Dr. Daniels is also the Vice President of the Board of Directors of Hogares Nacer which is a ministry of orphanages for children in Santa Cruz, Bolivia. This ministry is overseen by Miguel and Edly Zuchetti who are members of the Daniels church in Puerto Rico. The ministry consists of a home for 40 boys, a home for about 40 girls and a home for the Young men who are in the streets of Bolivia. Dr. Daniels has been involved with this ministry for the past 15 years.

Dear Fellow Laborers,

Greetings from the fields that are white unto harvest. In our last letter we shared with you the burden the Lord has put in our hearts which is redirecting our focus and our labors here where we have been working for the past 45 years. In Romans 1:1 Paul said "(called) separated unto the Gospel of God". In II Corinthians 1:1 Paul said "By the will of God". These thoughts have been in my heart from the beginning of us coming to the West Indies. That was over 45 years ago.

In this letter I trust I can share with you my vision of what I believe is the leading of God who has separated us unto the harvesting of the Gospel in the Islands of the Caribbean. I have never sensed being in the will of God for my life more than I do now. John 4:35 says "Say not ye, there are yet four months and then cometh harvest? Behold I say unto you, lift up your eyes and look on the fields: for they are white already to harvest.

I grew up in the home of a sharecropper in Knoxville, Tennessee. Even that was God preparing me for His purpose for my life if I would give Him my life. I learned many great principles that have so helped me understand the work of God (there is much work and preparation before the harvest).

- 1. The VISION My dad would say "Son, we are going to open up a new piece of land", I knew that meant lots of hard work and labor in preparing the land which doesn't take a lot of people, but it dose take people who are willing to work and maybe not see the fruit of their labor. Then after the preparation of the soil;
- 2. The PLANTING OF THE SEED This too takes hard work, back breaking work, and again it doesn't take a lot of people but it is a longer process. That which you have planted must be nurtured and cared for and again it takes patience and labor without seeing the fruit of your labor. After preparing the soil; after planting and nurturing comes;
- 3. The PRODUCE (fruit) But that is not the harvest time. Many a time my dad would say, "if we pick the fruit too green we cannot sell it. If we pick it too late (over ripe), we will lose it." Now harvest time was a set time, but you needed many people to gather the fruit at the perfect time. They also needed to know how to reap or gather the fruit. My dad would not just let anyone pick the fruit that was ripening unto harvest.

I believe the time of harvest has come to the Caribbean. We need people (laborers) to help gather from the laborers of those who have come and prepared the soil and those who have planted the seed of the Word of God.

God has placed a burden in my heart, that I can be one of those harvesters for the rest of my working years. With the two colleges that are here in the Caribbean which are training national pastors and laborers, we are ready and can start many local churches on every island of the Caribbean. Here is where you can help gather:

Many people have expressed to me they have a burden for the islands, therefore, we can be a means. Teams from local churches and people can participate. We will set up tent meetings with national pastors and schedule one team to come each week. We will have the field ready for the laborers to come. So if people from your local church want to be a means, put a team together of those who know how to reap in the fields and come join us gather the fruit. It's harvest time in the Caribbean! Come over and help us reap the harvest!
