## Ministry

Praise the Lord for His continued blessings and our constant businesses. Over the past few months we have continued to see God bless in exciting ways as we have seen more saved and had yet another baptism service. That is part of the difficulty in knowing when to write a letter, it seems every week there is some exciting event that I am waiting to include in the next letter; until I am later than I would like.

In June we celebrated the two year anniversary of the Gent Baptist Church, with a special service that we appreciated your prayers for. We came very close to beating our high attendance of 70 people and had the blessing of several familiar faces returning and even joining our church. We gave out 10,000 invitations and gospel tracts, thanks to a lot of help from our people. It was exciting to celebrate this event and to look back on what the church has accomplished in its second year. One highlight was to see we had received visitors from 55 different countries and every inhabited continent, a considerable increase from last year. Another that hasn't been mentioned, in a previous letter, is that we were able to give out over 60,000 gospel tracts; between our city and several others.

In July we celebrated National Day, by having Bro. Alton Mickle of the Calvary Baptist Church in Mons, Belgium to come and be with us. Then the following week we had the Baptistenkerk Antwerpen (Baptist Church of Antwerp), to join us as we are looking to do some outreach to help them in rebuilding their church. Both of these churches need your prayers, and would certainly appreciate them. Please pray for the Baptistenkerk Antwerpen as they look for God's will concerning a new pastor.

In August we had several special meetings at our church, but the most exciting one to tell you about, is our baptism service. We had yet another baptism here, as we baptized a young lady who was saved in our church in July; and then a man who has been faithfully attending our church since around the same time. Usually July and August should be slow, as most people go on month long vacations during this time, but God has continued to bless and grow our church in what should be the slow season.

I want to thank everyone for praying for Lory's Green Card renewal, we haven't received an official renewal but; we did receive an extension of several months. Please pray that we receive the renewal without the need of any interviews or travelling. I also want to thank everyone for their prayers, cards, and kindness; concerning my birthday. You all are always a blessing to our family and I deeply appreciate your friendship as we try to serve the Lord so far away, in Belgium. I will mention that in July my mom finally got to visit again and to meet Emily, for the first time; we thank the Lord for that.
