Rising Tensions

The political situation is really a mess with the preparations for upcoming local and departmental elections. The internal conflict is being agitated again as former members of the FARC along with the ELN now appear to be strongly allied with the national army of Venezuela. As Venezuelans continue to pour out of Venezuela, Maduro seeks to provoke Colombia into a conflict with plans to send the Venezuelan army to the border with Colombia. Ecuador now has over three million Venezuelans and seeks to limit the number entering. Please continue to pray for that situation. The economy here continues to be bad with high unemployment and a high cost of living.

Recently, in Valledupar, a pediatrician was killed by hit men who gunned him down while he was out jogging. Also, we have had problems with what appears to be someone stealing electricity from the house we live in and the Church as the monthly costs have gone up. There appears to be little or no law enforcement, and many get away with threats and violence. Please pray that the Lord give us wisdom to deal with that situation.

Travelling A Bit

At the beginning of July, Martha and Hannah travelled to Bogotá for badly needed checkups. When we travelled to Tunja, I was asked to preach there. Please pray for that Church because they have changed Pastors. We have sought to be a blessing to the current Pastor (Orlando Pérez) and his family as well. Martha helped a few days with the ladies. On the day I was preaching a young couple visited that Church for the first time. Martha got to know them and found out about a young married lady who lives in Valledupar. The young lady visited the Church one morning, and Martha was able to lead her to accept the Lord that morning. Please pray that the Lord place it in her heart to come to Church and provide for her transportation.

In Valledupar

The Lord allowed us to evangelize another couple who also want to get married and be baptized. It has been a time of testing for them since their young daughter that is five years old was recently hospitalized with Pneumonia. She is back home now, but please help us pray for that situation. We celebrated the fourth anniversary of the Church.

At the end of August, I was invited to preach a Mission Conference in Barranquilla to celebrate their seventh anniversary. My family and I had a great time of fellowship and trust that it was indeed a blessing for them. Bro.
