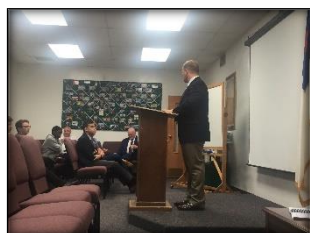


Dear prayer partners,
