The Lord has already provided a building for us to use as we seek to reach this area for Christ. I recently had the wonderful opportunity to be a part of **Macedonia's Missions Conference** in Statesville, NC. There, I was surrounded by thirty other missionaries from my board who had also answered God's call and were serving Him around the world. God ministered to my heart through the singing and many testimonies that week, but there was one special moment that I wanted to share with you all:
