David is starting a new series on The Church. We are planning to formally organize membership around our one year anniversary which is towards the end of October, early November. We have 3 discipleships going on and have seen much growth with these individuals.

Thank you for praying for the new believers and the believers that were away from the Lord and have come back. Christian and Luciana, the young couple I mentioned last letter, were excited and getting involved. They are still struggling with their marriage. We pray the Lord would give us wisdom in how to counsel and lead them. My wife, Hannah has began Bible Studies with Dali, a young lady from Venezuela and continues the discipleship with Betty, Dali's Mother-In-Law. We pray for the salvation of Dali's partner, Jesus. We keep praying for Yohana, a young mom of two who received Christ on the first Sunday of the church, who has gotten away from the Lord. Pray for more souls to be saved and for more opportunities to start discipleships. The highlight of July was our 1st Family Conference, three days of teaching and training. Thank you to all of you who were praying for this event. We had a wonderful


