We were also approved by the Spanish government for our visas! All we have to do is drive back to Miami to pick them up. We are currently on the road in NC, and we are making our way to PA and MI. We will make our way back to Miami, Lord willing, the week after Thanksgiving.

Additionally, we were able to purchase our plane tickets today for our move to the country to which God has called us! I am so overwhelmed by all that the Lord has done. We are thrilled to be able to tell you that we will leave for the field of Spain on January 14, 2020!!! God graciously provided the funds for our plane tickets through the generous giving of one of our faithful supporting churches in GA. We cannot begin to express how grateful we are for their love and support over the years and their generosity during this time.

Now, we ask prayer for just a few more things. We will need to send our shipping container in the next few weeks. We are praying that this will be a smooth process. We are praying for safety during this last major trip and the drive back to Miami for our visas. We ask that you pray that the rest of the funds will come in for our move and subsequent needs.

We are praying that each and every one of you have a wonderful and Happy Thanksgiving. We certainly have much to be thankful for this year! We are grateful for all that God has allowed us to do. We are looking forward to spending one more holiday season with our family, and we are eagerly anticipating January 14th! We love you all and thank God for you!

- Plane tickets \$7500 PAID
- Visa paperwork \$1000 PAID
- Shipping container with a few of our personal belongings and port fees \$2500 \$4000 \*Higher than we estimated
- Apartment \$4000 (required 3 months of rent up front and realtor fees) PAID
- Furniture \$4000 (beds, sofa, kitchen table, other basics)
- Health Insurance Estimating \$4000- \$6000 for the whole family for the first year which we have to pay up front PAID \*Praise the Lord it ended up being only \$3300!
- Car \$8000
