**PROTESTS** - Last month I arrived in Chile in the midst of an ongoing civil protest, that began because of a rise in the cost of public transportation. High school students protested by coordinating a fare evasion campaign, which led to the takeover and burning of the city's main subway stations. The situation escalated when organized protestors began to vandalize and rob local businesses. It has been reported that 34 Walmart stores were set on fire and 17 were completely destroyed. These protests are having a devastating effect upon the Chilean economy.

You may ask the question: *What about the missionaries? How has this crisis effected them?* Well, In my conversations with Jason, Jaime and Iván, I see two things. First of all, I see in them a strong **SENSE OF URGENCY**. They understand that their time to reach the lost of Santiago, Chile is limited, and that the night is coming when no man can work. The second thing that I see in these missionaries is an **UNWILLINGNESS TO WAVER**. There was no talk about diminishing their efforts. Our conversations were all about pushing forward and completeing the important work that the Lord has called them to do in Chile. Please join us in praying for these missionaries that the Lord would give them good success as they face the many challenges ahead.
