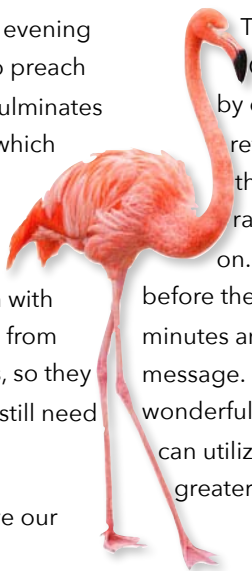
"Christmas is the time to praise the Lord", and God gave us some great opportunities to make much of Him this Christmas season.

At the very end of the night, before the refreshments, I take 15-20 minutes and preach a very clear salvation message. The response has been wonderful, and we are praying on how we can utilize this ministry opportunity in a greater way.
