Towards the end of 2019, we made an offer for the property where we were for 10 years. Unfortunately, but according to the will of God, the owners rejected our offer and gave us a month to leave.

The church saw God miraculously provide a place temporarily while we sought God's direction.

We are excited about a property right next door to where the church is meeting temporarily. They are asking a lot less than the other place but it is big enough for the future vision God has given us.

Currently, God's provided through much sacrificial giving over 13,000 USD. We are in the process of seeking God's direction on making an offer and believe that God will miraculously provide for the purchase.

Our vision is to have a permanent home for the church and a base for the Valley Baptist Institute by building dormitories and classroom space for the training of men and women to start more churches. Next month we will share the 20/20 vision God has given us.
