Ministry

Praise the Lord for His rich blessings in the previous year and so far in the new one. We have seen more people getting involved in various ministries, and especially men stepping up as leaders. We offered a soul winning class, where we had one of our faithful men to help teach it, in January. It is also exciting to see more people wanting to participate in soul winning programs. We have even seen some more ladies getting involved in teaching and working in the children's church as well.

Our big project this year is finding a new building, as you know by now we have well outgrown our current one and are finding our ministry opportunities to be hindered by it. We appreciate your prayers for us, and ask that you continue praying. Our people have been raising money for this, and with the help of a few churches and friends, we currently have around \$40,000.00 to put toward the purchase of a building. The building we had previously thought to purchase is no longer available, so some of the men and I are looking at multiple buildings every week, trying to find God's leading. However this endeavor will not be cheap nor easy, for most buildings large enough to meet our need, the down payment alone will likely require \$60,000.00 to \$100,000.00. Normally I would not ask for financial help, but since this is specifically for the church and not for myself, I have been advised to swallow my pride. All I ask for now is that you pray concerning what God might have you to do, and pray that God will guide us and provide for us; as we actively seek the building the He would have for us.

One major bit of news, is that we will be making a very brief return to the States. We were informed on January 31st, Lory's Birthday, that we would have to return for finger prints and documentation. This is for Lory's green card, something we will need the rest of our lives, and we are far too invested to lose it now. So because of this, we will be returning from February 10th until the 21st. I apologize that I will not get to see many of you in that time, but it is all the time we could afford to come back. Pray for us and for the church, as this will be the first time I have missed a service with them. Thankfully we have several men stepping up to fill my shoes, including the preaching; and some of Lory's family stepping into hers.

Personal

Concerning the big news of our last letter, we have learned that baby Haley number three, will in fact be a girl. Josiah has said all along he wanted a brother, but it seems he didn't pray quite hard enough. This does however put the pressure on Emily, as she now is the one with a potential replacement. This news comes just in time, since I will be seeing most of my family for the first time in almost three years, upon our brief return. Josiah and Emily will be meeting everyone, except my mom, for the first time.
