We have had a very busy couple of months, but we could not be more excited. The move to Spain was very involved. There were 4 adults, 3 children, 14 suitcases, and 1 very uneasy dog (don't ask). However, the flights could not have gone more perfect. All of the children slept well on each flight, and there were no delays. We made it early to Palma and began furniture shopping immediately. We had several things that we had to get just to make sure that we could stay in our house the first night.

Praise the Lord, most everything has gone quite smoothly. We were able to get our house livable. We are still waiting on some furniture, but we are comfortable in our home. It is a strange feeling after three years of traveling to finally be settled in one place, but we are very grateful.

There have only been two major inconveniences. The Lord has already helped in one situation, and we are waiting patiently on Him to resolve the other issue. Please be in prayer with us that our residency appointments will go well and that our shipping container will be delivered soon. It is currently stuck in port in Valencia, Spain, waiting to clear customs. Unfortunately, most of the things that they are asking from us to help clear customs, we do not have. We are trusting that the Lord will help in this situation in His time.

The third day after we arrived, we were able to go soulwinning with our church. It was such a blessing to be able to spread the Word of God in the city to which God has called us. We have asked for your help to do what God has called us to do, and now we are doing it! Aside from the regularly scheduled time that our church goes, Jessica and I both have already had the opportunity to talk to people about church. It's sad how many people do not even know what Baptist is. There are many people here that know quite a bit of English, so we have enjoyed when we get the opportunity to speak to people in our community.

We have so enjoyed the church since we arrived. There are roughly 16 regulars who are all wonderful people! We are still praying for some of them to accept Christ as Saviour, and it is encouraging to get to hear the Gospel every week in a country where it is not so readily available. Please pray that the church will continue to grow and that we will be able to see many come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

I must publicly thank Markie and Christy Bullock for all of their help. They have been such a blessing to us! We would not be as well off as we are now without their assistance. Markie has constantly been with me helping with the language barrier and getting everything accomplished legally that we need to complete.

We have one of our residency appointments scheduled on the 12th of this month. We are asking the Lord to work everything out that day for us to be secured here in Palma for the next year. We were also able to enroll in language school. We will be starting in the beginner class on March 2nd. Please pray with us that God will give us a quick and easy understanding of the language. We are looking forward to being able to speak with more people in this area.
