She was the most special godly lady, with such a sweet captivating smile and exemplary Christian character. In the days and weeks that followed her passing we have heard the precious accounts coming from far and near, from so many, who have been touched by my mother's testimony. We miss Dr. Mom so very much, but we are comforted by the truth that we will meet again. Oh, what a day that will be! We do appreciate your prayers for our family, especially for my Dad as he continues with treatment of lung cancer.
