CHURCH PLANTING UPDATES FROM THE WEST INDIES

Haiti is having many problems within the government which leads to demonstrations and rioting making it very difficult to get needed supplies. It is amazing to watch God provide food, and gas (when available) and other essentials often at the very moment of need. Pastor Demil continues to be extremely faithful even in the midst of great difficulties. Pray for **Connie and Sandrine Anderson**, and the children's home, Christian school, church ministry in Haiti.

Grenadines are a small chain of islands that lie between Saint Vincent and Grenada. **David and McKenzie Ballinger** are serving on the Island of Bequia where they have established Bible Baptist Church. They are currently renting a house to hold services. Please pray they can get the owner to commit to a long-term lease which would give them full access to the house allowing them to live upstairs and make some needed repairs on the house.

Tunnel Vision often occurs in ministry when we become so focused on our current ministry that we often fail to see the need outside our ministry. **David and McKenzie Ballinger** certainly **DO NOT** suffer from tunnel vision. While they are busy and focused on their church plant in Bequia, they have a burden for the other island in the Grenadines especially Canouan, Mayreau and Union. These islands are located within 40 miles of Bequia and have a great need for a gospel preaching church. The Ballingers have a burden to purchase a boat making weekly visitation, tract distribution, and laying the groundwork for a church plant on each of these islands a reality. I have visited both Union and Canouan with Bro. Ballinger and have seen first-hand the need.
