We have arrived in the USA for furlough. We touched down this past Tuesday afternoon after around 30hrs of traveling. It's good to be back in Georgia. We have already had a refreshing time of getting to see friends and family. We want to say a big "Thank you" to Whitfield Baptist Church for all the help getting settled in.



Just a day after we arrived we headed to Gatlinburg, TN for our sending church's annual marriage retreat. My pastor asked me to teach a couple sessions. We had a blast. It was a fantastic way to start our furlough and for Corli and I to celebrate our 16th anniversary. My pastor, Wayne Cofield, does a phenomenal job leading and teaching these marriage retreats. We left South Africa on a very positive note, God had answered so many of our prayers concerning the work there. He raised up around 9 preachers in the church!
