Dear Co-Laborers,

As I sit in my study reading in Matthew 28 about the great commission, I think about what a blessing it is to serve the Lord in church planting. As we travel across the states seeing part of God's great creation and also reading His Word, it reminds me how beautiful Heaven will be.

Praise God He is still calling folks to the mission fields around the world. But at the same time He is calling new families to be missionaries in the great United States of America. We have new families on deputation for ministries here in the United States. The Rickey Howard family are going to the state of Utah. The Scott Pannell family and the Benjamin Beaudoin Families are going to South Dakota. The Benjamin Cooley family are going to the Midwest. We are blessed to have these families. We are looking forward to working with these new families along with all of our other families now serving in the West.

In our last prayer letter I shared about both of us facing cataract surgery. They scheduled Sister Hutchens' first because they said I had a blocked tear duct that had to be fixed before the cataract surgery. I turned out that I have droopy lower eyelids instead of blocked tear ducts and the cataract surgery had to be done first. Also at Sister Hutchens pre-op, they found wrinkles on her right eye that had to be treated before her cataract surgery. So they put me in her surgery spot. I had one on January 20th and the second on February 3rd. My eyelid repair is scheduled for February 27th. She had to wait at least 3 to 4 months before they can do her cataract surgery. She will probably wait until we get back in the fall to do hers.

We have been in meetings in North Carolina, Georgia, and Missouri since our last letter. We are making plans to head west. We are waiting to recover from these surgeries and the snow to melt. We will start by going to the Southwest first. I'm still helping Brother Nathan Saunders in that area until he gets his support raised. Then we will head to the Northwest. We plan to spend more time in North and South Dakota after we have seen the others in the Northwest. We still need more help in the Northwest.

In closing I would like to thank you for all your prayers and financial support/ We could not do the work that God has called us to do without your help and prayers. We love you each and everyone.
