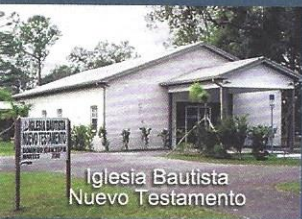

## JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2020 PRAYER LETTER

March 13, 2020

Dear Prayer Partners:

We thank each of you for your prayers and financial support which allows us to give the Gospel to the different groups of farm workers that come to the area to work on our farms and in our citrus groves. We have migrant workers and year-round workers in: our citrus groves (orange, grapefruit and lemon, etc), tomato fields, squash, cucumber, lettuce, potato, rice, corn, beans, sugar cane chili peppers, bell peppers, watermelon and cantaloupe, eggplant, celery and cattle farms. However, I came across a bee farm with migrant workers just outside of LaBelle. It is huge and the migrants pull travel trailers to live in and take tractor trailers full of bee hives that are full of bees to pollinate crops. They were preparing to take these bees to California over 3,000 miles away. The owners are paid well as there is a great shortage of bees at this time. Four persons were saved in this trip to the Bee Farm. Amen!

Praise God our church is in nice condition again since the flood. We got tired of waiting for contractors to do the repairs and did most of the work ourselves. It is beautiful now. AMEN! New carpet, baseboard, nice chairs to replace the ruined pews and we repaired the mold damaged areas in between the walls. Finally it looks great and the terrible smell is gone. Once we get a new water fountain installed all will be better than before.

Some of the names of those saved are as follows: Juan Lopez, Tamara Lopez, Jennifer Mendez Ortiz, Edith Villegas, Geneva Zamora, Robert Zamora, Ashley Olmedo, Herminia Cruz Acosta, Juan Alfamirano Soto (plus others).

During one Thursday night, someone going fast through our parking lot totalled out one of our small vans and the insurance company only paid about half of its value. It was old but had low mileage and great cold air. Now we need 2 vans, a small one and a 15 passenger van. (There were no witnesses).

Please pray for: more souls for Jesus Christ, the need of 2 vans, more workers especially for visitation, for our problem with getting folks in church with this virus situation, more support for us and for God to bless all Bible believing churches in this hard time.
