We share their burden as we consider the great need to get the Gospel to the forgotten people of the Far North. I am reminded of what Jesus said in the verse above, John 9:4. God has called us to His Work and time is very short. As Missionaries labor around the world to give the Gospel to the lost, many of whom have never heard the name of Jesus, the sun is setting and night is coming. The lands of the Far North, with all of their beauty and splendor, are filled with millions of people who are without Christ. They are living and dying lost. Iceland is facing a revolution against religion of any kind. How true are the words of Paul, "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them." (2 Corinthians 4:3-4) However, the darker the night, the brighter the Light! Thank you for praying for our family, the missionaries of the Far North, and every family serving with Macedonia. We are blessed to labor together with you in the task of making sure every person hears the glorious Gospel of Christ. We believe God is still fervently calling for laborers, and we are excited to spread the word across our country about people just next door who have no church, no Bible and no preacher. Perhaps, the Lord is calling you. Let us know and let us help you.

We are excited about our July missions tour of Canada, which will take us to the missionaries of Quebec, Ontario and regions where there is no Gospel witness.
