There was a group visiting from the United States who were a great blessing as well. Around 170 people participated, either attending or working in the 2 VBSs, and 10 people made professions of faith. ## **Land Update**

We are excited to be returning to Peru in June to continue working in the area of Tacna known as Viñani. It is our desire to see a new church planted in this area. As we prepare for this transition, we have looked at various pieces of property for the new church. It costs between 25K-30K for a lot that measures 1,700 square feet. Through God's grace and the generosity of His people, we have been able to save up a little over half of the needed money. Please pray that God would give us wisdom as we look to find a place that we could purchase for this new church plant in Viñani.
