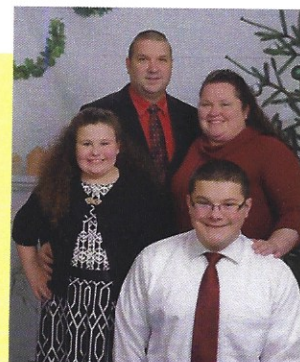

Our church was greatly encouraged when we had a new lady visit this past Sunday. She had heard about our church from the packet left on her door! Door to door works!

Recently a lady at church was telling me how she had invited the bakery worker at our grocery store. She connected with her because they both had previous addiction problems. She said, "I told her that she should come to this church because they love you and don't judge your past." What a wonderful testimony!

Another dear lady in our church recently got a burden for her four great grandchildren. She wants them to grow up in church like she had raised her children and grandchildren. She got permission from the parents to bring them to Sunday School. We were all thrilled when the parents showed up for the main service as well! They have been coming for two weeks now. We are praying for the Lord to show all of them their need of salvation!
