Dear Praying Friends and Faithful Servants,

March, April, 2020

Thank the Lord for traveling safety and deliverance from Covid 19 so far. I know that things are starting to open back up, but with that is the increased threat of contacting this very contagious virus. Please be careful and avoid crowds if you can.

We have been in Plant City, Florida helping Freedom Baptist Church which is in need of a pastor. We have never canceled any services for they have a large auditorium and it is easy to maintain social distance. When we came there was about 7-9 people attending. Last Sunday we had 23 with 4 first time visitors. It was a great service and very encouraging to us. I have received 19 resumes from all over the country and out of the country including Australia. We have not had the first candidate because of the virus and travel restrictions. Our first official candidate will come this month (May) Lord willing. The only thing I regret is that I won't be preaching when they start coming. I have certainly enjoyed preaching and teaching for all four services during the week. We tried to send the services over the net but we don't have a signal in the church and it is too expensive right now for the church to get internet in the building. We have been here longer than we thought we would and now that we are starting to see prospective pastors it shouldn't take a long time with 19 men applying. Please pray that God will send the right man for this church, and the pulpit committee will have His discernment.

There are so many churches just like this one in need of the right man. I believe this shut down will cause some churches to close their doors. The church rescue ministry will be greatly needed to help keep them open. Pray for churches that won't recover from this pandemic. Pray also for more men to enter this type of ministry. We are still not receiving a salary from these churches, but the Lord is meeting our needs, praise His name. Most of the churches that are needing help are just barely getting by with their finances and can't pay a salary so the position will be bi-vocational.

Sister Dee and I are fine and still wearing masks when we go out. She is still not sleeping well and tired all the time. She has been faithful with her C-pap machine but it doesn't seem to help her much. Thank you again for your prayers and faithful support. Without your help we couldn't help these churches. Keep looking up.
