We have now been able to meet as a church for the last 3 weeks, and it has been so good to be back with everyone. We have also added several new ministries at the church. We are now having our mid-week service on Wednesday. A couple in our church is hosting a young teen class every Tuesday. Bro Markie will also be teaching a preaching class after the teen class for a couple of the young men in the church that have expressed interest in preaching. Also, Christy and Jessica were able to start having a ladies' meeting every Friday. It seems that several of our friends and neighbors may be interested in coming, and we are praying that this will lead to more people in church!

Our church was able to purchase a new piano last month, and now Jessica is playing for our services. We were using a CD for the hymn singing, which was working just fine; but it is so encouraging to watch Jess play the piano and Rounellys play the guitar every week for us to sing for the glory of God. Jessica was also able to start the children's Sunday School class this week. Of course, Colton is the only child that age, but he so enjoyed it; and we are excited for him to have the opportunity to learn. Next week, we will be having our first baptism for the church which is an exciting milestone for us all as well.

On a more personal note, we finally received all of the furniture that we ordered when we first arrived in Spain; and we are very grateful for the wonderful place that God has given us. We are also continuing our language studies. We are currently doing 3 days a week through an online class, but we are praying that we will be able to get back to 5 days a week at the school this month or next. We have not yet received our residency cards. They are sitting at the police station waiting for us; however, the police station is currently closed. We were told that when they do open back up we will have to make an appointment to pick them up; and currently there are no appointments available. Please pray with us that God will work all of these situations out according to His will.

Megan and Madison turned one year old on May 2nd. We cannot believe they are already so big. We thank God for giving us our wonderful little girls. We were able to have a video conference party for them (which did not end up so well for Madison as she burned her finger on her candle), and we are so enjoying watching them grow!

Before concluding, I would like to extend an immense thank you to all of our supporters! Even during this trying time, you have been faithful to us; and we cannot tell you how much that means! Thank you for being faithful to God. He has certainly used you in a mighty way to encourage our hearts.
