I have had the privilege of preaching for our church in Tacna, as well as for the Emmanuel Baptist Church in Macará, Ecuador, which is pastored by Richard Macedo, a missionary sent out of our church. Also, through funds generously given by faithful supporters and others, Pastor Henry and the church folks have been able to distribute almost 200 bags of groceries. This has been a wonderful opportunity to
