July 2020

Deborah and the boys are fine, they are happy to be out of school. Deborah maybe more than the boys. Joseph and I are learning the guitar. Deborah is enjoying visiting with our neighbors. Joshua and Jeremiah are trying to see how much dirt they can get on them (Deborah loves that).

I want to thank everyone for your prayers and support. It is unbelievable the faithfulness of God's people. At the beginning I was thinking we might have a few difficult months because of people not being able to go to church, but God has shown himself faithful as usual.

We have been dealing with the corona virus scare here and we have only been able to have church services for a few weeks now. We have to wear masks, test people at the door for fevers, and disinfect every chair and have a hand washing station before the people can enter.

Pray for a boy named Felix he has been hanging around known thieves in the area. He made a profession of faith but when he went off to boarding high school, (very common here) he hasn't been the same. Some of our other boys are finding it hard to get back in the habit of coming to church. Many of our boys have found groups of friends that are unsaved and they are pulling them toward the world. I know as a pastor that we can't stop people from doing stupid things but it doesn't make our hearts any lighter. Michel, Nyamah, and Papa have all been in and out, this isn't like them.

Pray for us as it isn't smart to do Saturday visitation right now. We have also had to postpone our Saturday youth bible studies because of the scare. This has changed the way we have had to do most of our ministry for now. I have not been able to go out and spend time with several of the men I was working on. Because we are foreigners many people are scared so we have to be overly cautious not to scare our people.

The Good news is that Jeremy Kenney and I have been able to get on the radio and preach Monday to Friday 5:30-6 am Friday nights at 9pm and Sunday morning at 8:30am. This puts each one of us preaching 5 times a week. I am preaching through Geneses and Jeremy is going through Hebrews at the moment. There are churches literally everywhere you look here, but very little gospel is preached. We are able to get the truth out as well as help many of our people to hear the Bible explained. Thanks to preaching on the radio we have had a few visitors come to church they don't usually come back but there is some interest.

Pray for our people to get back faithful to church. Pray for the people we have been witnessing to for a long time. Pray for a guy named James, Emanuel and several others that we have witnessed to for years. Pray that some will get saved soon.

Pray for the Kenney's as they are waiting to be able to go back to the US. Our borders are closed here in Ghana and we are not sure when they will reopen. Pray for the Launderville family as they are waiting on visas to get into the country. These two families have been an answer to prayer for help in the western region of Ghana. There are so many villages and cities that need the gospel here. For now, the radio gives us a way to get into many we will never get into any other way. Pray for nationals. Pay God would call many Nationals here that we can train them.
