Ministry

We praise the Lord that your prayers for our church were answered immediately. Within a week of when most of you received our last letter, the government allowed us to legally meet again; with much restrictions in place. While we never stopped meeting, or keeping our church open to the lost; it was a blessing to have that request answered. For the first month we were only allowed ten people per service, so we had to conduct three to four services, to get everyone in. It made for some difficult Sundays, especially as I chose to do a different message each service, and to conduct each one as a full service; thankfully our people were willing to get involved and take on whatever responsibilities they could in the services.

For the last couple of months churches have been allowed to hold meetings of up to one hundred, however the government restrictions made it impossible to host more than about twenty in our regular building. For this reason God led us to rent the conference room of a local hotel on Sunday mornings. The cost is reasonable, and the room allows us plenty of space to seat as many people as we need to. I do not feel this is viable as a long term solution, if the restrictions persist; but for now this too has been an answer to prayer. We still use our regular building for all other services; however it is quite common to fill it up even in the evening services, due to the diminished capacity. Please pray that God will help us to find the building that He has for us to purchase soon, so that our church can grow past these restrictions.

We have also been able to get back into our street ministries and evangelism, with little trouble. All of this was illegal for a time; but now we can preach on the streets, give gospel tracts, and go door knocking; and so far the only issue is being required to preach in a mask. Thankfully while we had to change some of our methods, we never had to stop giving the Gospel. God gave us many ways to continue to evangelize, here and abroad. One of our more interesting projects here, was that we used chalk to write the gospel all over the city, and direct people to a simplified website we made just to give the gospel. Outside of Belgium God gave a weekly opportunity to hold Bible study in India, with a large group through the internet.

Surely our most exciting news is the birth of our second daughter, Hannah Maria Haley, on July the 12th. She was born healthy and well; Lory however had some complications after she came home and had to be readmitted to the hospital for a few days. Both of them are well now and really appreciate your prayers for them.
