We are very grateful for the opportunities we have to serve here. A couple weeks ago our church had a special music Sunday and that was fun and exciting to work with and see the awesome talent the Lord has placed in our church amongst the members.

On our last letter we asked for prayer regarding our residency cards and, praise the Lord, we have received all of them, so we are officially residents of Spain. Unfortunately, in about 3 weeks I will begin the paperwork for our next renewal! Jessica and I have also started back to language school 5 days a week. This means more frustrating days ahead, but we are determined to learn as quickly as we can.

In July we celebrated Jessica's birthday and last week we celebrated Colton's birthday. Fun times for our family! The girls are close to walking, so just imagine our house with 3 small children running around! We are staying busy with our ministry but enjoying our time with family as well.

To our supporting pastors and churches, we have been sending prayer letters every other month via email and a hard copy mailed. If you have not been receiving them, please let us know as we want to be sure you are all able to keep up with our ministry.
