July-August 2020

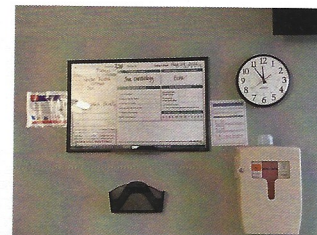

The transition of the sale and purchase was all by God's design, as the new owner allowed us to remain in our home until we closed on the new one in Florida.

Moving Day: On August 19th family and friends, including missionaries and Old Suwanee members, began loading our household belongings onto a 26-foot Penske truck. We are grateful for those who came to work with us to accomplish this monumental task. Thursday August 20th, we closed on the purchase of the house in Crestview, Florida and loaded a second Penske truck. Friday the 21st our son Nathan, his friend Jim, Cathy, and I drove 2 trucks, the Yukon and Mazda to our new home. We were thrilled to have this part of the move behind us.

Mind to Work: Saturday morning several members from 2 Florida churches were ready and available to help us unload the trucks. However, we were diverted to the emergency room due to an episode of Afib. While we were unavailable all morning, those faithful volunteers unloaded all our belongings into our house and a storage unit. They willingly served in the heat on our behalf.

Mind of God: Sunday morning just after arriving at church we were once again diverted to the emergency room due to chest pains. This was certainly not the way we wanted to begin our new ministry. After being admitted to the hospital overnight we had to reflect on God's will for our lives. His ways are not our ways, but His ways are higher than our ways. This was only the second time we had ever been admitted to the hospital. As of now we are awaiting an ablation, to correct the Afib on September 18th. Please pray this procedure will be successful, and we will soon be back to our desired strength.

Ministry of Vision: Just over a year ago Pastor Mickey and Kim Muse came together with a few families, to begin the Vision Baptist Church in East Crestview, Florida. The ministry which began in a Hotel has since moved to a church building, which we are renting. A building fund has been set up and we are actively seeking property to purchase by this time next year. The people are excited and committed to giving, working, and praying. Will you please pray and consider giving toward this endeavor as we continue to serve the Lord by faith? The church is growing and already supports 3 missionary families. Thank you for praying for us as we serve God wherever He leads us to see souls saved and Christians strengthened.
