Dear Co-Labourers,

Greetings in the lovely name of our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. Isaiah 40:31 says, But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength. As we think on this virus, our minds go back to when it put our travels on hold. During that time we could stay in touch with our western church planters by cell phone or internet.

Finally on August 6th, we were able to head west. Our first meetings were in Doe Run, Missouri to relieve Bro. Jeff Hawks for one Sunday. Then we were at Second Baptist Church in Festus, Missouri for the following Wednesday night. We left there on Thursday and got to Amarillo, Texas on Friday. I preached in Summit Baptist Church on Sunday the 16th. Next we headed to Vernon, Arizona to relieve Bro. Luther, Quintana who was scheduled for back surgery. He called before we got there to say they had delayed his surgery. We got there on Wednesday and preached for him that night. Then we went to Cottonwood, Arizona for meetings on Sunday the 23rd. We returned to Vernon on Monday then headed north toward Idaho on Tuesday. This was a four day trip.

In Idaho, we were with Pastor Danny Vaughn and family at Clearwater Baptist church in Orofino on the 30th. Next we went to Colfax, Washington, with Pastor Tim Wall at Macedonia Baptist Church for their Wednesday night service. Then on the road again to Idaho and was in Blessed Hope Baptist Church in Pinehurst, Idaho with Pastor Andrew Inboden on Sunday morning September the 6th. I was also able to give a devotion at the men's prayer breakfast on Saturday morning. One of the men visiting asked Christ to save him at this. Praise the Lord. That Sunday afternoon, we drove to Victor, Montana and was in the evening service of Solid Rock Baptist Church with Pastor Shane Agee.

Monday was an exciting day in September, we drove from Victor, Montana to Big Tiber, Montana in snow and freezing rain. We were thankful that it wasn't sticking on the roads. That evening we met Pastor Martin at Bible Baptist Church in Big Timber and had supper with him. Pastor Martin and Pastor Inboden are not with MWBM but they are doing a great job for the cause of Christ. Our next stop was supposed to be Red Lodge, Montana with Pastor Russell Pruitt, but they had 10 inches of snow so we went on to Billings, Montana. I preached there at Grace Baptist Church for Pastor McKinney. We were able to stay there a few days and did get to see the Pruitt's as well as have some time with the McKinney family. On Sunday afternoon we drove 3 hours to Buffalo, Wyoming. I preached there on Sunday night for Pastor Robinson at Buffalo Baptist Church. We stayed there a few days to try to be an encouragement to this pastor and his family.

Our plans were to head to South Dakota to be in 4 churches, on to Nebraska, then to Iowa and finally back to Georgia by the end of October. However, I received a call from Pastor Quintana in Arizona that they had scheduled his back surgery for September 30th. He did not have anyone to take his church during his recovery time. So I called and canceled all the meetings I had scheduled and we headed 1,100 miles back to Vernon, Arizona. We will be here for about 4 weeks filling in at Welcome Home Baptist Church.

As for Sister Hutchens and myself, we are doing okay, just tired. We are thankful to be back on the road doing what God has called us to do. It is a blessing to be involved in church planting in the western USA. Again I say the need is so great. The fields are white unto harvest but the labourers are few.
