We understand the challenges that you are also facing during these unprecedented days. We are thankful for your faithfulness to continue to reach your communities with the Gospel and for your faithfulness to the cause of World Evangelism.

Dear Prayer Warriors, thank you for praying for Ethan's arm. He has seen tremendous progress and has finished all of his physical therapy. The wound has healed and he has a pretty cool scar to show off to his friends. The Bahamas continues to be plagued with the Coronavirus. Our national infection numbers are listed as one of the highest in the world, per capita. We are still subject to lockdowns and it has caused us to have to switch our services back to online only. In the beginning of October, Heather and Ian started to show symptoms for COVID. Heather was tested and the test came back positive. A few days later Aiden and I also started to have symptoms. The boys bounced back fairly quickly and Ethan never showed any symptoms. Heather and I took a couple weeks and we are still

easily fatigued and I am having some mild breathing issues.

With the infection rate so high, we have had many of our church people that have also been sick. We have had four families in the past two weeks have someone die with COVID. The most recent was one of our church member's mother. She was only 52 years old and had no pre-existing conditions. The healthcare here is extremely poor. The hospital is so overrun that Samaritan's Purse came over to assist with some emergency field hospitals to house some of the patients. Please continue to pray for the Bahamas. The government needs to open up the economy. Most Bahamians work in some sort of tourism-based industry. With the country shut
