Brother David Wade has already started printing another big order for 1,000,000 Spanish tracts. It is to be shipped to our missionaries Leroy Rolston, Marti Roberts and Gene Trask. These Spanish tracts are going to Honduras. Brother David says these tracts will be distributed to area missionaries and pastors by foot or by boat. The cost of the paper, \$4000, has come in but the shipping costs will be about \$4000 to get them there. Please lift up this project in your prayers.
