## Ministry

We hope this letter finds you well, as we go into the Christmas season. God has certainly been good to us, and I trust each of you can say the same. We have seen many new people come into the church, since our last letter. However, since our previous letter, Belgium has also entered another lockdown. Currently it is illegal to hold a church service, however we are able to exploit the loopholes we found in the previous lockdown. This means that we must hold smaller services, under many restrictions, but we can legally have church. We are currently holding at least three services every Sunday, each one with a different group of people from the church; so as to get everyone we can into one of these services. Sadly, as far as I know, this means, we are one of only two churches in all of Belgium currently using this loophole to meet.

Prior to this lockdown, our church services were filling up again, and were almost back to how we were before Coronavirus first hit. We also, for the first time since February, were able to host a special service and a fellowship meal with it. This sounds like a small item of news; however, it was a great encouragement for our church; and really helped our people. Most everyone is still attending the church each Sunday in one of the services mentioned above, or at the very least through the livestream. Pray for us as even still, our church is doing fantastically, and I sincerely believe the Lord is going to bless us even more, once we are out of this second lockdown. I have included on the second page some pictures of our International Day Service, our last Sunday before the lockdown began, and of our family as well.

During the beginning of the lockdown, we were blessed to host a special live stream revival for our church. We were joined online by preachers from around the world, who preached to our church, using the technology we have available. We were then able to share these messages with people all around the world. Many people I have spoken with were not aware, that since this past spring, we returned to street preaching and our other street ministries; and while much of it is once again an issue, we are still actively working to give the gospel, and to find new ways to do so. We have had opportunities to help other missionaries as well, by giving special offerings to help in their various mission projects.

Our biggest need is certainly for a larger building, especially once this lockdown is lifted. God has tremendously blessed us as many have continued to give to this cause. We currently have over \$55,000, toward the down payment on a building. This puts us very near our expected need, as we anticipate a down payment of at least \$60,000, but possibly more, for most any building that would meet our need. We just want to praise the Lord for His bountiful supply and thank each of you who have been a part of helping to meet this need. Our biggest prayer request is for the Lord to lead us to the building that He has for us. As said many times before, it is very difficult to find a building suitable for a church, but we are diligently searching. At this point, when I call most any realtor in the city, they already know who I am.

- Pray for our family that we might serve God faithfully, and raise Josiah, Emily, and Hannah for the Lord.
- Pray for churches here to be legally allowed to reopen, and for restrictions to not hinder their ministries.
- Pray for our church, that God will help us to finish this year strong, and to be blessed in the new year.
- Pray for Lory as she is trying to get her drivers license, and faces difficulties from the lockdown here.
- Pray for our building, as we look constantly for a new building, and for God's provision in this need.
- Pray for the Baptist Church of Antwerp as we try to help them, while they search for a new Pastor.

Thank you for all of your faithful prayers for us, you are a much needed part of the ministry, and will never know how much of a blessing you are to us, at least not on this side of eternity.
