Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

January 2021

I want to thank each of you for your prayers and support 2020 was a trying time for all of us. There were so many uncertainties with the corona virus as well as apathy and many difficulties. Thank you that gave to help with the flights to and from the US for my mother's funeral as well as Christmas for the boys. I miss many of you brethren. Pray for a friend of mine and a supporting pastor Jimmy Jones, as he is retiring after pastoring the same church for 43 years. He was such a blessing to me and a great friend to my father in law. I have several preacher friends that are about to retire. I am grateful for each of these men which stood with me and I am also sad to see them getting older.

My mother passed away in September. This has been hard for our family. Since her death, this has been a very trying time. I was able to go back to the US a week after her funeral to be with my Father and my sister. We were there for about 2 months because of the paperwork to get back into the country of Ghana. This was time that we needed to get some things straight and to spend time with my sister and family. Pray for my children as my mother's death was unexpected and has greatly bothered them.

The boys have started back in school, and they were a little bit behind but they have caught up. God has helped them to get all their books and get to where they needed to be. We took a two-day short break and went to the ocean, it is what our family needed. We haven't had much time together this last couple of months.

When we returned to Ghana it was back to work. Jeremy Kenney and his family are in the US for furlough so I am now preaching 9 times a week. 3 times a week in church and 6 times a week on the radio. The need here is so great that I can't turn it down. Corona virus shut our church down for a few months but it opened the radio station from Friday nights only, to Monday -Friday morning from 5:30-6. This door is open to us and it has been a blessing and God has met the financial needs. Pray for me spiritually and physically as preaching 9 times a week is draining on both. I have been preaching though several books of the bible and started the new year preaching through the book of Acts. Pray for this ministry as we have about two-hour radius from almost the border of the Ivory Coast to two of the largest cities in Ghana. It also reaches into a larger city that to my knowledge has never had a fundamental work.

Our church is up and down in attendance as well as spiritually. I have been preaching through several books of the bible and I am now preaching through first Samuel. We are trying to look at the character of many people in the bible. Most of the people in our church are teenagers. Pray for Emmanuel he can barely read, but he is the most faithful in the church and God has greatly changed him. Pray for our church that it might grow physically and spiritually .
