Dear Co-Labourers,

Greetings as we write this prayer letter. We think back over this year and now it's time to think on the Christmas story of the birth of our Saviour the Lord Jesus Christ and the start of another New Year. We know this has been an unusual year but the Lord is still in control. We hope you had a blessed holiday season by keeping Christ in the center of it.

It has been a blessing to travel over the western part of the United States and not only see the landscape but also see what God is doing in churches. Many of the churches out west have been going through COVID-19 and are having services on Facebook or services in their parking lot. They need your prayers.

Sister Hutchens and I got home on October 26th. We had traveled close to 10,000 miles, 8 states, and 10 churches. Because of COVID we had to cut our travels short. After we got home I tested positive for COVID on October 30th and was sent to the hospital. I stayed overnight and was sent home. On November 1st, Sister Hutchens tested positive. On November 10th we both had low oxygen and blood pressure and were told to go to the hospital. We both had COVID pneumonia. Evelyn was sent home on Saturday the 14th and I was sent home on Sunday the 15th. After this, I continued to run a low grade fever. It went to 100.3 and I had some other symptoms so I had to go back to the hospital on December 5th. They did test and blood work and sent me home. The low grade fever continued for a little over another week. We are doing much better now, just trying to get our energy back. We are out of quarantine but are being cautious.

We are looking forward to 2021 and getting back on the road again. In closing, we want to thank you for all the cards and gifts. We trust you all had a Merry Christmas and will have a Blessed and Happy New Year. Thank you so much for your prayers and financial support. We couldn't do what we do without you. May God bless all.
