Also the work in Chile has been blessed by the ministry of CORE (coremissions.org). CORE is a great ministry that facilitates temporary support for national pastors until the local churches are able to support them full-time. CORE has been a huge help to several of the Chilean pastors that have graduated from the Bible college. CORE has a great system of accountability in place to ensure that the pastors being supported are of sound doctrine and practice. They would be an excellent consideration to your missions plan.


