There are days that Jessica and I are so frustrated because we feel we cannot understand anything, but we were just talking about how we feel the Lord has allowed us to become comfortable being out in our city. We are praying that we take many steps forward with the language in the year ahead.

We have watched what seemed like three small babies grow into three incredibly sweet children. We have absolutely loved getting to watch them grow and enjoy where God has placed us. We pray every day that as soon as they are able to understand that they will accept Christ as Saviour.

If I am being honest, this has not been the easiest week for Jessica and I. However, we take comfort in knowing that God chose us. He chose us to come to this wonderful country and show His praises to the people! God saved us! He rescued us from that terrible place called Hell. He gave us a wonderful gift.
