Most unsaved people drink all night.

Please continue to pray for Argentina. I have some very sad news. Argentina now has made abortion legal and free. Women can go to any hospital and have a free abortion.

We appreciate your prayers as we return to the States in the month of January to continue with deputation. We also want to thank you so much for all the Christmas gifts. We sure appreciate them.
