Matthew 14:18

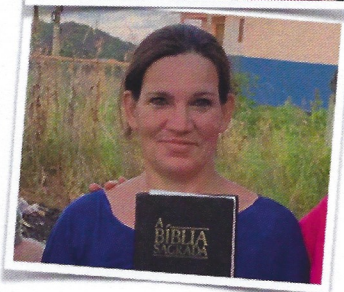
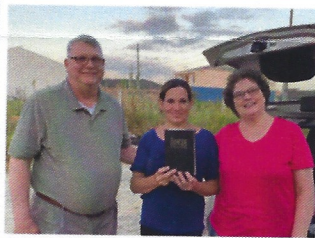
Greetings Fellow Laborers in Christ,
