To Our Faithful Brethren In Christ Jesus,

We are grateful for another opportunity to communicate with you by means of our Prayer Letter from Valledupar, Cesar, Colombia. We still have a lot of wind, and the temperatures have been at times over 100 degrees. The weather outlook is that sandstorms from the Sahara could have an affect here. We received a small amount of rain on Valentine's Day. We can still see that things look a bit green as people continue to water their lawns.

It is hard to say how bad the economy is here. Unemployment continues to rise. Street crime is getting worse with people being robbing of bicycles and other things while out on the streets exercising. The department to the north of us (the Guajira) has an infant mortality rate of 46 percent that die of starvation.

Still Dealing With COVID

Colombia has endured one of the longest lock down times of any country in the world. Even though Valledupar has gone to Yellow Alert, the lock down has affected daily life here. People are still afraid to attend Church. Others, that we would like to share the gospel with, have expressed that they are not willing to let us visit them. Still, we need a lot of prayer for the Lord to provide opportunities.

With The Church

Please pray for a man I recently wrote about that has prostate cancer. His name is Manuel. Bro. Willesmer and his wife had symptoms of COVID. Thank the Lord, they are better now. Due to the fact that he had an unconfirmed case, we had to cancel the Church service for the Sunday that followed. Thank the Lord, it appears that no one has received COVID. The government is ready to vaccinate those that want to.

With the few services we were able to have, a young man (Jorge) accepted the Lord. Please pray for him and that we can follow up with him and disciple him. Also, we were able to visit and witness to a doctor that suffered a great deal of damage from COVID. He accepted the Lord. Please pray for him, he really needs a miracle. His name is Juan Fuentes. We thank the Lord that we continue to have some first time visitors.

Prayer For Us

Thank you for praying for Martha and our dealings with COVID. The pneumologist cannot believe she stayed at home and didn't go to the hospital or use oxygen. She will start lung therapy in March to try to improve her breathing capacity. Please help us pray that the damage is only temporary. Also, I have just went to the dermatologist to have a few places on my skin checked out. I should have the results from the biopsies in a couple of weeks. Please help us pray that it all checks out OK. The sun here in Colombia has been pretty rough on my skin.

Other Prayer Needs

Also, thank you for praying for Hannah to find the Lord's will in going to college. She has been accepted by PCC and plans to attend there in the fall. Please pray that we will be able to do everything we need to do here and see her off. We do not know what we will face in the way of travel restrictions. My mom had to have surgery again to keep her arteries open. She has been losing weight and her appetite. Please help us pray that the Lord will allow us to visit her this year.
