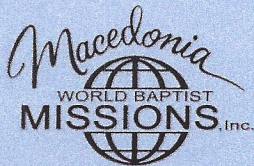

We are happy to see how God opened doors for us during our time here in Santiago de Chile. This month I had the opportunity to present our ministry virtually in several churches. I spoke to the Trinidad Baptist Church in Florida. They have a big heart for missions. I also had the privilege of sharing our ministry in a mission conference at Pastor Joel Solomon's church. The people there have always been so kind to us and after the service they expressed their love and affection for our family. The Faith Missionary Baptist Church in Antofagasta was another door that the Lord opened for us to minister.

They have a Bible Institute, and I had the privilege of teaching there for three days this semester.
