A young mother from the community named Stephanie returned to church the following Sunday with her two young boys and nephew. Although the church went through a lot last year we are beginning to see spiritual growth in our people and a great excitement and burden to reach the lost in our community and around the world through faith promise missions.

The past few weeks we have been having new people join our class who have not heard the gospel before and it has been encouraging to see them there and to be able see a seed planted. **Family-** Sis. Deanna came down with Covid the last few weeks of her pregnancy and

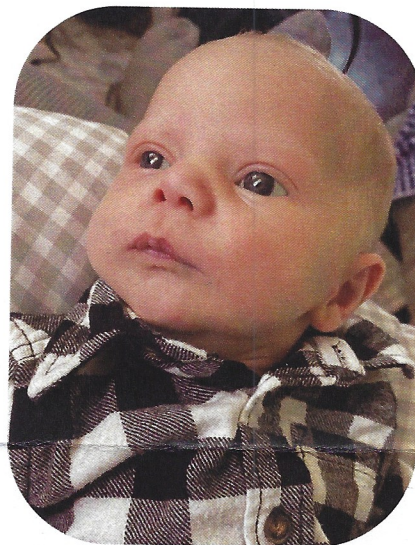
