With the loss of these two families we lost two Sunday School teachers and a junior Church teacher. But I am excited to report that our folks have stepped up and three of them have surrendered to teach Sunday School. We also lost all of our piano players and unless the border from Canada opens soon we will be conducting our services without a piano. Krista, my daughter, is our main piano player and she and her husband live in Canada and can't come down. For now myself and another man in the Church will be doing the music. I play the guitar and Mandolin and he plays the guitar so that will be our music. A new couple has started going to our Church. He is a Navajo Indian from New Mexico but has moved into the area and she is Chippewa. They are not married but give a testimony of being saved and want to get married soon. This is a common scenario in the Indian culture. Most never get married but when they get saved and start coming to Church they realize they are living in sin and get married. This has happened more than a few times in the Church. I won't let them join the Church if they are not married but that situation has never come up. They usually get married by their own convictions. I am hoping they will grow spiritually and get involved in the Church.

We had an Easter fellowship with an Easter meal after Church on Easter Sunday. It went very well and we had a good crowd with some visitors. We even had a legislative representative for our district in the services. Many are stepping up to get things done around the Church. I put a list of items needing fixing etc on the weekly Church bulletin and when I come by the Church during the week I see that someone has come and fixed something on the list. Our people are growing spiritually so even though our post covid attendance is not what it used to be we are making progress and I am sure the Church will continue to grow as we get back to our soulwinning and visitation efforts.
