We travelled on into Oregon for the Sunday night service with Summerville BC in Summerville where God allowed Benjamin to present the work and preach the Word of God. The rest of the month included our being in churches throughout OR, MS, SC, and AL. The Lord allowed us to be in 10 churches and preach or teach 9 times in these meetings. It is an honor every time we are enabled to stand and open God's Word and preach the unsearchable riches of Christ. We saw many respond and many encouraged from the Scriptures. In our travels, we witnessed to a Mormon and a Spiritualist in Idaho, who both rejected the truth as it is in Jesus. In Oregon, we spoke with Betty, a travelling nurse from CO, and pointed her to God's manifested love for sinners in the death of Christ. Please help us pray for these souls and the many more scattered throughout the Northwest USA who are lost in the darkness and night of sin.

Our Rejoicing: Since our last letter until this time, we have had 7 more churches choose us to be their messengers in Oregon and the Northwest USA bringing us to 44.6 %. We travelled in excess of 6000 miles in April and though we had hindering circumstances such as fresh snow, high winds, and road closures—the Lord has been very gracious and helped us every mile of the way. We also rejoice in God answering your prayers and directing our hearts on where we are to begin ministering after deputation. The Lord has pointed us to Central Oregon,

and the city of Redmond. Here is a town in the heart of Oregon with 38000+ people and no Independent Baptist Church. Please pray for God to begin preparing the hearts of men in this area to receive the truth that a church might spring up there and be planted for the glory of Christ! We can never say it enough—Thank You to every church that stands faithful to support us and pray for us; we could not go without you! May Christ find us each and every one standing strong to further the truth of the Gospel of Christ and to forward the faith of Christ in these last days of Laodicean, lukewarm churchianity, and rank apostasy.
