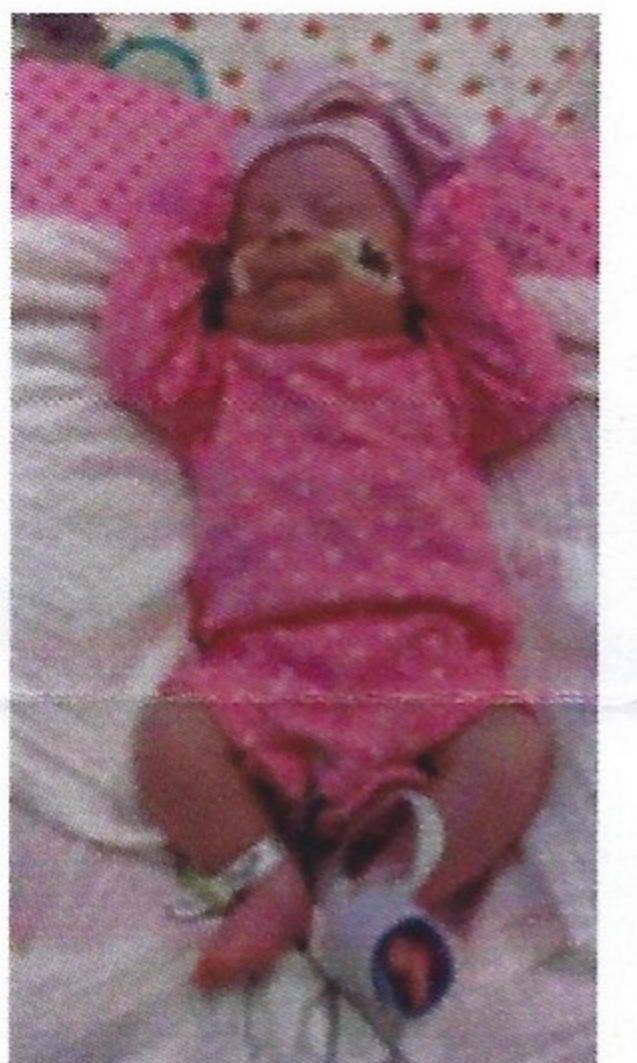
Dear Prayer Warriors,

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. I pray you are well and enjoying God's blessings on your life and in your ministry as you seek to do the will of God. Anita and I thank God for your faithful prayers and financial support. Your faithfulness has allowed us to serve the Lord with Macedonia World Baptist Missions for over 32 years.

As I write this letter, we have **three new missionary families** at the home office preparing to begin deputation. What a blessing to see men and women continue to surrender to the great commission! Pray for these new families as they begin deputation that God would hasten the day they are fully supported and can minister in the country in which God has called them.

Please pray for missionary Connie Anderson who has served in Haiti since 1985. Sis. Anderson serves in a remote area of Haiti where for water, they collect rain, and their only electricity comes from their generator. Crime in Haiti has increased greatly over the last 18 months. At times it is difficult to get the needed supplies such as gas to run the generator and cooking gas. While food is not always in great abundance or variety her testimony is that "God has never let us go hungry." Please pray for Sis. Connie Anderson, for her protection and needed provisions. The orphans and abandoned children she cares for are blessed to be raised in a Christian environment where they hear God's Word on a daily basis and witness the love of God lived before them in sis. Anderson's life. Pray these children trust Christ as their Saviour and grow to be a faithful witness and shining light for the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Thank you for the calls, text, emails, and cards letting us know you have been praying for the situation with our daughter's pregnancy. The doctors were forced to deliver our fifth grandchild at 28 weeks to protect the life and health of both mother and child. Amelia Bentley was born on March 27th weighing one pound eleven ounces and was twelve and three-quarter inches long. Melissa is doing well and was discharged from the hospital a few days after delivering. Praise the Lord, Amelia is growing and gaining weight. She now weighs four pounds eight ounces. She still has a feeding tube and is on oxygen as her lungs are not fully developed due to being delivered so early. Predictions are that Amelia will be in the NICU until mid-June. Please continue to pray for Amelia, especially for her lungs to develop and for her to learn to take a bottle so they can remove the feeding tube.
