These certainly are times that I have never seen before. We are able to see the sustaining power of God and that He is faithful and His mercies are new every day.

Although this is supposed to be the beginning of the rainy season, we really haven't seen much rain. The temperatures have been reaching 100 or more. In spite of the lack of rain, things have been getting greener, there are lots of beautiful flowers to see.

The economy has gotten even worse. The word is that reviving it will be a great challenge of this century. Colombian Immigration is offering to give I.D. cards to the Venezuelans here. There are 40,000 in Cesar that are able bodied and looking for work. As hope is fading for lots of people, crime and kidnappings are on the rise again.

The Latest With COVID

COVID has been taking a great toll here. Last week, as I write this, Colombia had the third highest number of COVID deaths in the world for that week. This is what they say is the third wave. As the health system here in Valledupar is collapsing, the government reacts with more restrictions declaring red alert and lock downs. It is once again affecting the schools, families, and the population in general.

Please Pray For The Church

Even though a young couple has visited the Church travelling from a distant town, we have been able to have fewer and fewer services in the Church building. Also, most of the people in the Church have had a personal situation involving COVID and others are reluctant to attend when they can. Bro. Simeon's wife was in the hospital for a few days with COVID, and is much better now, but still deals with the secondary effects. Please pray that the Lord help us find opportunities to evangelize.

Thank the Lord, I have been able to begin a discipleship with Bro. Jorge. He has some great personal and family needs that I ask that you help us pray about. Bro. Willesme is doing well with discipleship and growing little by little. It has been sad to see the destruction that the enemy is causing to families. Please pray for sister Nini and her family as her home is facing being torn apart.

Prayer Needs For Us

The restrictions for COVID have made it harder to get regular medical care and check ups. That was the case with the biopsies I had done. Both turned out to be cancer. But the Lord made a way, and I was able to get the surgery done and have the cancer removed. I have had to stay out of the sun for a while. I guess lock downs are a good time to do that.

We still have lots of things to do before seeing Hannah off to college. Please pray that we will be able to spend a brief time with my mother and help Hannah in this time of transition for her. We cannot thank the Lord enough for all He has done and for giving us such a family in the Lord who pray and give as you do. May the Lord be with all of you to bless and give grace in your time of need.
