Dear Pastor and Friends,

Greetings in the wonderful name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

It is a great blessing to report that the 1,000,000 tract project for Honduras is finally ready to ship. The total amount of tracts is 1,175,890. This includes, as we mentioned in our last letter, a tract printed in the Miskito language spoken by the Miskito people in Northeastern Nicaragua and in Honduras. Gene and Robin Trask are missionaries to the La Moskitia region of Honduras.



The reason for the additional 175,890 is due to the 4" tracts that we print on the 19"x25" paper we use. These 4" tracts are printed on the 4"x 25" strip of the 19"x25" that would be waste. Richard Vance and I designed these 4" tracts to save this paper. This gives us 12 tracts per sheet and these extra tracts are just sent on to the missionaries.



We hope to have these on their way ASAP. Please pray that these tracts will arrive and are distributed and that Satan will not be able to hinder the work and Word of God. Thank you to all who gave toward this project.

In our last letter we asked you to pray for our granddaughter

Eva. She was born with an annular pancreas which was causing a restriction of the duodenum. After birth, the doctors did an immediate surgery to bypass the restriction. This helped but they were told that it might be necessary to do more surgery. A lot of prayers have been given on her behalf. On her last checkup, the doctors told Mark and Emily that the pancreas is no longer restricting her duodenum and that it is working normally. Also, the doctors believe that the surgical bypass is not being used and will close off and heal up on its own. This is a miracle answer to prayer.



In April, Florence had an accident when she tripped on a floor mat and broke both her tibia and fibula bones at the ankle. It required surgery and a plate with 9 screws to repair her ankle. She is recovering well but it has been a slow painful process.

In 2012 we purchased a printing plate maker. This plate maker is not working and no longer manufactured so there are no parts available. We have decided to try to purchase a used more modern one at around \$20,000. It is expensive but absolutely essential to the printing operation. Please pray with us that we will be able to purchase this soon and not hinder the tract production.

Florence and I want to thank you again for the prayers and support that you have given us. We know that your giving is a sacrificial gift and we want you to know that your support has helped to reach millions for Christ. I believe without a doubt that every soul that is saved is added to your account in Heaven.

We pray for you that our Lord will continue to keep you safe in the days ahead.
