

Our family is grateful for the outpouring of love expressed by so many who have been touched by my parents lives and ministry here in the USA, Brazil and other parts of the world, and we thank you in advance for your continued prayers for us during this time of grieving.

This has been our 6th furlough, and we can say without hesitation that it has been incredibly unique in several ways, and we thank the Lord for how He has orchestrated every detail in accordance with His will for our lives. It has been a clear reminder of the Bible truth that "...all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28. Our hearts are filled with gratitude for all that God has done in us, for us and through us during this time here in the USA. We are now scheduled to return to Joinville, Brazil, for our 7th term, on June 24, 2021. Please pray with us as we prepare to travel. Pray also for funds needed to pay for our plane tickets as well as luggage fees among other important items needed for the ministry.

God has opened a tremendous door of opportunity in partnership with one of our supporting churches to begin a building project for the Igreja Batista Vitória (Victory Baptist Church) in Joinville. Please pray with us as we develop and execute this worthy project. Also pray for us as we seek to evangelize the lost and establish personal Bible studies and discipleship with new converts and for direction for a future church plant.

In our last letter we asked for prayer concerning our need for a vehicle when we returned to the field. Thanks to a dear supporting family, and two supporting churches, the Crooked Creek Baptist Church, in Athens, GA, and the Shannon First Baptist Church in Shannon, AL, for their generous offerings toward this need. Praise the Lord! Please pray for us as we seek to purchase this vehicle soon after returning to Brazil.

In closing, we ask prayer for our family as we say goodbye once again to our friends and loved ones here in the USA. We thank God for the opportunity to serve Him and for each one of you that is a partner in ministry through prayer and financial support. Thank you.
