We were told the tumors are shrinking, but how much, we do not know. Please continue to pray for my wife.

We are now going to see a shoulder specialist for Debra's left shoulder since it has been giving her a lot of pain. Our doctor ordered an MRI, and the results show a good bit of damage. Possible surgery is in the future. Please pray that she will have complete healing and no more pain.

The church in Iquique and the mission in Alto Hospicio are holding their own despite the lock down that they have been under. They had opened it up to allow twenty people to come but were shut back down. The new restrictions only allow them to have five plus the preacher in the service. Most are able to watch the service by zoom. Please pray for them as they continue to hold services under these restrictions.
