Michael is leading the start of another church plant in Akron Iowa (about 20 miles from Elk Point). Atreju comes from Moville Iowa (about 40 miles away) we have talked about the possibility of starting a church there in the future. His father-in-law, who also comes to Elk Point Baptist, is starting a Bible study with the high school track kids that he coaches and his mother-in-law already does Bible clubs with the elementary kids! Christian is graduating High School this year and has a real heart for God and people. Now the Lord has led Ryan, a recent Bible college grad to help in the work! My prayer is that through the church in Elk Point that we will be able to plant at least a dozen churches before Jesus comes!

The many souls that have heard the Gospel for the first time and have been and are being saved, are souls to your account. From the first to the most recent, Kaelyn (15), got saved a year ago, her mom and dad, Randy and Rachel came to church and trusted Christ a few months ago, her friend Blake started coming and got saved on March 8th, now his family is starting to come!

You share in the blessing of homes and lives that have been and will be restored, "*For we are labourers together with God*:" I Cor. 3:9!

Melanie and I thank you from the depths of our hearts for being our partners and our friends! Your love, prayers and support have meant everything to us!
