May proved to be an extremely busy yet productive month for us. We had a great time as we traveled south for our orientation with Macedonia World Baptist Missions. While there we were able to meet the staff at the home office as well as a few new missionary families. We were also able to preach in and give updates to three of our supporting churches and present in a church that voted to take us on for monthly support. While down for orientation we also got word from one of our supporting churches that they voted to raise our support and another individual from one of our supporting churches also contacted us to let us know they were personally taking us on as well. We praise the Lord for this.

The family is doing well and was refreshed by getting to visit with family in GA between meetings. While in Georgia we were able to celebrate Elijah's eighth birthday with the family. Benji Beaudoin will fill in for us August through October of this year while we are on furlough, and it is a blessing to know that the pulpit and congregation at Pleasant Valley Baptist Church will be left in good hands. As we prepare for our travels, we are praying that God would supply us with a camper that can be towed behind our Ford Expedition. We would use this camper to live/travel in for the duration of our furlough. We would appreciate your prayers for this need as well.

Please continue to pray for the Pleasant Valley Baptist Church and the surrounding areas as we endeavour to reach our community for Christ. Pray that the church will grow and that the Gospel will continue to go forth. God has placed some big things in our hearts concerning the ministry here in ND and we want to be busy about the Master's business! Thank you for your prayers, support, and service to our Saviour.
