

It is wonderful to come to you as churches and supporting individuals and bring you another update of what God is doing in His ministry. We are so thankful for your support, prayers and care. As we endeavor to be faithful to God's work on our end, we are very thankful for you who are faithful on your end. You are actually the rope holders in the work of God.

Spring 2021

Several new Endeavors have taken place since our last prayer letter. The first is that our church has started a sign language ministry for the deaf. Pastor Craig Lang from Reserve, N.M. came and gave us a course in A.S.L. for a solid week. Since then God has allowed a team of people to really catch on to it and every service there is interpretation for the deaf. We have had several families who visited that were deaf or had deaf members. At this point we have seen two deaf people call on the Lord for salvation. Our young people, as well as some of our ladies, really seem to be excited about being a part of this ministry.

Back in March, we were able to go down to Casas Grandes, Chihuahua ,Mexico and had the 2-year anniversary missions conference for the church that we have started in that town. They are running in the mid-30s every week. We are discussing with Pastor Valenzuela (who is a member of our church here in Santa Fe and is working as a missionary out of our church) about starting a second mission church on the other side of town. Right now our biggest prayer is getting him the paperwork to come to the United States where we can raise him some support. This would enable us to have the finances for this new work. If you would pray for him as well, he is having some trouble with his diabetes.

We've been working for the past two and a half months on remodeling our church platform. It was a complete demolition. We completely reconfigured the whole layout and size of what was already there. Our people at the Harvest Baptist Church have worked faithfully and vigorously. They are so excited to see the finished product coming together. It is extremely exciting to see people catch the vision that God has laid on the pastor's heart, taking it as their own.

Camp season is coming upon us. In the next couple weeks we will be going up to our camp in the mountains and de-winterizing everything and doing a spring cleanup. We have a group of churches renting the camp in the middle of June. We will host our church camp in the middle of July. And then our church and another from here in New Mexico are making plans to have a men's retreat as well. So be praying about this ministry as it continues to grow.

Our family is doing well. The kids are learning through their home school. They are learning to work with character here on our farm. We added a 35×8 greenhouse as well as extra grow beds this year. On the farm we have chickens, pigs and sheep which we sell or eat. We are continuing with the house remodel as we need to enlarge it at this time. We are in the process of wrapping our house on three sides with an addition to add more bedroom and closet space.

Can you pray for God's work here in the southwestern part of the United States as well as Mexico? The fields are white unto harvest, we must pray for Laborers.
